### **Introduction to Bee Keeping**

**March 6<sup>th</sup> 9am-1pm**

Spend the morning with Paul Scutt, bee keeper at Snipes Farm. Learn about the anatomy of the bee, sociology of a hive, harvesting honey, hive construction and inspection. Field instruction will be followed by a farm fresh lunch. Those interested in keeping bees and more advanced study may arrange for additional sessions. Paul has kept bees for 25 years, and has been a teacher on three continents.

Bring your family to the farm as spring arrives and our new growing season begins. Our arboretum has over fifty trees, and an old Black Gum dating back 300 years lives in our woods. Get new ideas about your own veggie gardening! Each person will leave with something to take home to tend and grow.
