TUESDAY CLASSES

It Begins with the Seed (7/6) Seeds are little miraculous packages of life! We will find seeds where they live in fruit and flowers, we'll sort seeds, plant seeds and eat seeds!

Green and Growing (7/13) Let's meet plants big and small at the farm! We will learn about roots, stems, and leaves and then get to eat some. Then we'll make art with different leaves that we find.

Flowers are Amazing (7/20) Let's find blooming flowers and learn how they turn into fruit! We will explore colors and shapes of flowers and fruit and get to sample some along the way.

Animals We Tend (7/27) Let's meet our chickens, turkeys and horses! We will learn about the places they live, what they eat and how we take care of them.

THURSDAY CLASSES

Farmers Grow Our Food (7/8) Let's meet farmers and learn about the work it takes to grow food. We will help with chores and harvest yummy veggies to snack on.

Soil is Amazing! (7/15) Let's learn about the amazing stuff we walk on every day, and how farmers add more and more life to soil every season. We will meet the talented worms who live and work in the soil and learn about composting.

Wildlands and Wildlife (7/22) Let's explore the woodlands and find the places where deer foxes, owls and other wild animals to live. Let's listen to the heartbeat of a tree, and to the other lovely sounds of nature. We will make a bird feeder to take home.

Food , Fabulous Food (7/29) Food is beautiful, fascinating and delicious! Let's experience the tastes, crunches and colors of fruits and veggies do.

WEDNESDAY CLASSES

What is an Orchard? (7/7) Let's take a hayride to the orchard to see what's growing and learn about how we grow fruit! We'll feed the roots with mulch and learn about the important life of bees! Then we'll pick yummy blueberries.

Water is Life (7/14) Our bodies are made up of 80% water and farmers need to keep plants watered for them to stay healthy. We'll water thirsty plants, and visit the Jordan's Creek to listen to its babble and see who lives there!

Shelters and Homes (7/21) Farms give shelter to animals and plants, and birds and other animals make their homes ingeniously out of sticks and mud and other things from nature. We will visit different shelters and homes and see if we make one of our own.

Everybody Moves (7/28) Whether you are a seed or horse or worm, you have to get around somehow! Let's watch what they do and find different ways that we can move! We will make mobiles with different things we find on our walk.
